LF Fetlock:	<u>Fragment plantar lateral P1 - Easy to remove arthroscopically</u> . Mild sesamoiditis – medial sesamoid. Horse should be monitored closely to ensure the sesamoiditis does not get worse. Minimizing body weight helps

RF Fetlock: There is mild sesamoiditis - medial sesamoid. This horse should be monitored closely to ensure the sesamoiditis does not get worse. I would not push this horse too hard during sales prep. Minimizing body weight helps decrease tension on the suspensory ligament and changes observed in sesamoids.

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LH Fetlock: NSF*

RH Fetlock: Fragment apex lateral sesamoid. Easy to remove arthroscopically and has a very good prognosis. There is evidence of mild sesamoiditis associated with this sesamoid as well.

Left Knee: NSF*
