LF Fetlock: Fragment plantar lateral P1 - Easy to remove arthroscopically. Mild sesamoiditis – medial sesamoid. Horse should be monitored closely to ensure the sesamoiditis does not get worse. Minimizing body weight helps decrease tension on the suspensory ligament and changes observed in sesamoids.

RF Fetlock: There is mild sesamoiditis – medial sesamoid. This horse should be monitored closely to ensure the sesamoiditis does not get worse. I would not push this horse too hard during sales prep. Minimizing body weight helps decrease tension on the suspensory ligament and changes observed in sesamoids.

LH Fetlock: NSF*

RH Fetlock: Fragment apex lateral sesamoid. Easy to remove arthroscopically and has a very good prognosis. There is evidence of mild sesamoiditis associated with this sesamoid as well.
